Each bid must be made on the prescribed forms furnished with the Contract Drawings and Specifications, including Proposal Form, Schedule of Prices, Bid Bond Guarantee, Site Inspection Affidavit, Acknowledgment of Receipt of Changes to Bid Documents, Stockholder Statement of Ownership, Non-Collusion Affidavit, Consent to Investigation, Bidder's Qualification Form, NJ Business Registration Certificate, Public Works Contractor Registration Certificate, List of Subcontractors, Plan and Equipment Questionnaire, Disclosure of Investment Activities in Iran, and Bid Opening Checklist.

Bid_must be accompanied by a Consent of Surety and a Certified Check, Cashier's Check or Bid Bond of not less than ten (10%) percent of the amount bid, and not to exceed \$20,000.00. Bids may be submitted by mail, but will be considered only if received on or before such date and time.

Bids may be submitted by mail, but will be considered only if received on or before the date and time specified. The Borough will not assume responsibility for bids forwarded through the mail if lost in transit at any time before bid opening. No bids will be received after the time set forth above.

The Borough also reserves the right to correct any erroneous mathematical computations in any proposals submitted, and to consider the Bid on the basis of the corrected total or totals. The written figures shall prevail over the numerical figures.

Attention is called to the fact that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, c.127 (NJAC 17:27), and P.L. 1977, c.33. Bidders are required to comply with the New Jersey Business Registration Certificate Law, P.L. 2004, c.57. Bidders

are required to comply with the Public Works Contractor Registration Act, P.L. 1999, c. 238. All bidders must include a copy of their Certificate of Registration with the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development with the bid or must provide proof that they have submitted a registration application to the Department (copy of application and proof of payment of fee). Failure to provide either a certificate or proof of submission of an application to the Department shall be grounds for rejection of the bid.
